



Asian Harm Reduction Network (AHRN)

Media Training:

AHRN's Media Department regularly produces documentaries on harm reduction projects in Asia. In order to stimulate in house video documentation and reporting, technical media training programs and workshops can be customised to meet the specific needs of participants. These customised training programs can range between one and ten days (as required).

Training programs are mostly 'on demand' – which means that organisations seeking training services from AHRN must provide information about themselves, their training needs, and the funding options available to cover the costs of training. Content of trainings can range from (option 1) filming and camera use to editing, through scripting, writing, interviewing and distribution of productions. Another aspect of capacity building in this field relates to (option 2) the adequacy of language used and media portrayal of public health issues in an effort to sensitise filmmakers and media representatives to cover those issues in an appropriate way.
